How to change the Source Language from German to English when translating Admidio files

Follow these 8 easy steps below...

1: First select the language that you will translate to, click on the language.

English (en) 99%	1 untranslated strings
German (Germany) (de_DE) 99%	1 untranslated strings
Danish (da) 96%	54 untranslated strings
Dutch (nl) 86%	212 untranslated strings
Italian (it) 80%	307 untranslated strings
Portuguese (pt) 61%	599 untranslated strings
French (fr) 59%	623 untranslated strings


2: If you came from the wiki on Admidio's homepage, this step is skipped. Goto step 3, otherwise if you see the Admidio folder just click on it.



3: Select for example, "main program strings", click on that line



4: On the pop-up window that pops up, click the button "Translate"



5: Click on the "Settings" icon, in the top right corner of the webpage.




6: Select "Show source string in German"



7: This will bring up another pop-up window.

Click the little scrolldown menu arrow, now you can select which "source language" you want, you SHOULD base your translation on the ENGLISH (en) language file.



8: Now when you have selected the English (en), click the button, Set language, and you're done!
